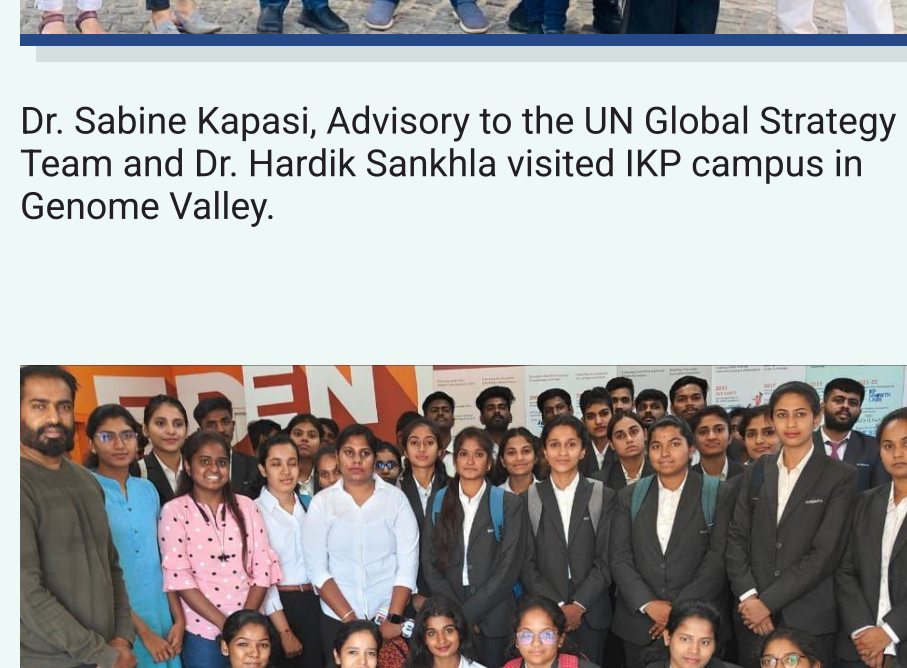


Logy.AI touched lives of 500k+ people through its solutions last year with global clients like Colgate and Apollo in India and Africa trusting the company's AI technology. The company has a patent, has published multiple clinical trials and reached a revenue of over USD 300K despite being bootstrapped.



Arthro Biotech has achieved a significant milestone by becoming the first Indian company to obtain all the necessary regulatory permits to produce Black Soldier Fly (BSF) insect protein. The company has also made its first commercial shipment of BSF insect protein to Japan. Additionally, Arthro Biotech is about to launch the world's first bio-pesticide made from BSF larvae, expected to be released in India later this year.

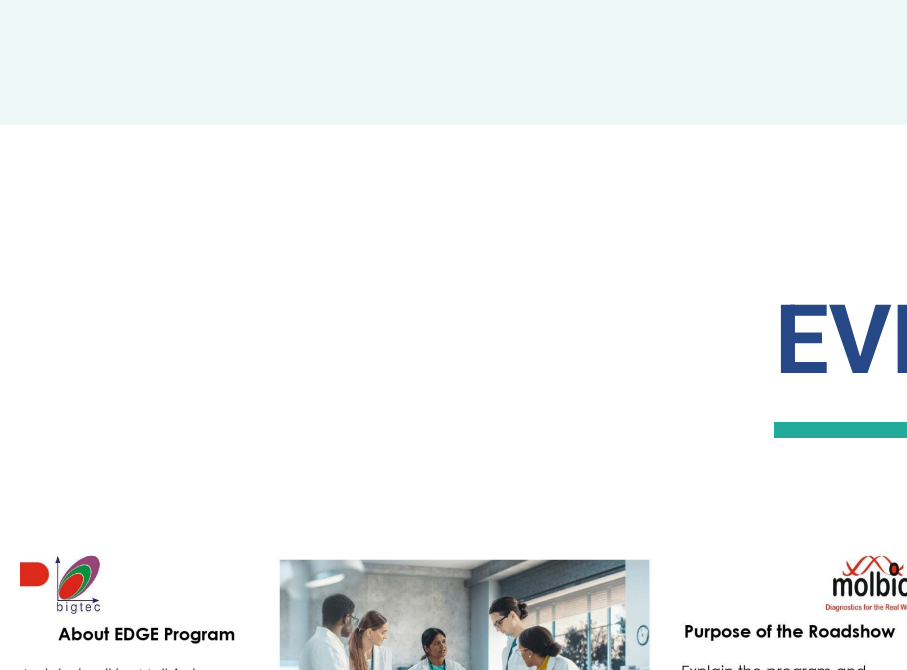

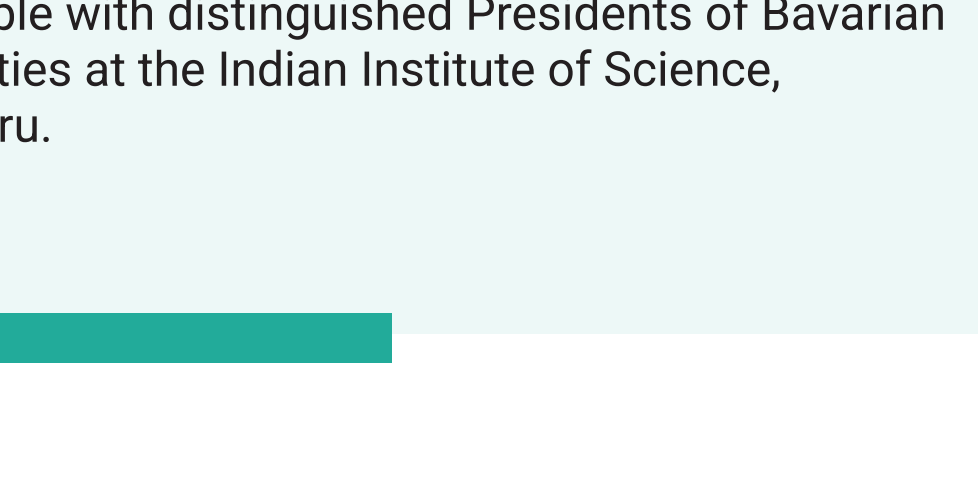
