
A Transformative Leadership Transition at IKP

At the launch, we also signed MoUs with AIC Jyoti Institute of Technology, Bühler Group, and the Transdisciplinary University to drive innovation and sustainability in this sector.



Pioneering Biomanufacturing at IKP



We had the privilege of hosting remarkable visitors in 2024




During their visit to IKP in January, the German Centre for Research and Innovation - DWIH New Delhi aimed to foster strategic collaborations between Indian and German incubators, enhance cross-cultural ties, and advance entrepreneurial ecosystems.

A Mission Officer from the French Consulate in Bengaluru, accompanied by representatives from the Indo-French Chamber of Commerce and Industry, visited IKP in June to explore ways to strengthen Indo-French collaborations in innovation and identify opportunities for technological advancements.



Inaugurating The Narayanan Vaghul Building at IKMC2024


